Bath Bench

User Manual

Safety Precautions

Ensure that all the push buttons lock into position and protrude through the holes in the legs.

Check that all the fastenings are tightened.

Check the rubber tips for rips, wear & tear, replace if necessary. Do not stand on the bench.

Always sit in the centre of the bench, do not lean on the edges of the bench as this can cause instability.

Do not exceed the maximum weight limit of 135kg (21 stone). The bench is only suitable for use by one user at a time.

Assembly

Inspect all parts for damage before assembly. If there is any damage - DO NOT USE. Contact your stockist for further instructions.

- Lay the seat upside down on a flat surface, so that the 4 leg receptacles are facing upwards.
- Fully insert the first leg into the leg receptacle. Rotate the leg until it 'clicks' into position.
- Repeat for the other 3 legs, ensuring that they have all 'clicked' into position.




- (a) Backrest

Models 12002KD & 12002KDR are supplied with a backrest.

First attach the back support tubes (c) to the backrest (a). Ensure that the push buttons snap out through the holes. Then attach the backrest to the seat by inserting both back support tubes into the back support receptacles on the seat. Ensure that the push buttons snap out and lock the backrest in place.

Height adjustment



To adjust the lea height:

- 1. Push in the buttons (as shown).
- 2. Adjust the section to the required height.
- 3. When this height is reached, release the button but carry on adjusting the section until the buttons lock in position.
- 4. Repeat for the other 3 legs.

Caution! Ensure that all 4 legs are set to the same height.

Maintenance

To maintain the quality of finish, we recommend that the bath bench is wiped down and dried after each use. Periodically, clean the stool with a damp cloth and mild detergent or disinfectant. For example, chloride disinfectant (solution of 1000 parts per million) can be used.

Check for any damage to the seat and/or legs, if in doubt, remove from service.
